TECH ARTICLE: How To Install the Latest Gadget for Your Street Rod

Here at *Fraud & Bust'um*, we're constantly on the lookout for the newest and most cutting edge equipment needed for the Street Rodder who's looking for attention. This month, we'll show you how to install the **Bodacious Billet Bleach Burnout Injector**, available from the same folks who brought you the **Bodacious Billet BBQ Grill & Trailer Hitch**.

Our test vehicle is a Terrible T-Bucket kit car (available at 800-BEAT-YOUR-T). Featuring a Dipped-In-Billet small block Chevy, T400, and 9" rear-end. The kit includes a Mustang II front-end, which looks great on this fenderless Ford!

Step 1

Attach the billet injector to the adjustable 1" square tubing. Since some rears are wider than others, you will have to attach the other end to you rear however you can (welding, bolting, superglue, duct tape, etc.).

Step 2

Set the gallon bottle of Clorox in the bed of the T-Bucket, using the optional bungee cord to keep it still. Poke a hole in the bottom of the jug and insert the braided steel line. The system is gravity fed, so be sure to keep the jug higher than

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
